Theme: On the Move

Entries open 1 June 2017

Entries close 3 July 2017, 5pm

CONDITIONS

1. The Literary awards are open to all forms of writing: short stories, factual articles, memoirs and poetry
2. You do not have to live in the Campbelltown area
3. Your story must relate to the theme and have a reference to the Campbelltown area
4. Entrants must be unpublished (people with academic publications and self-publications online are still eligible to enter)
5. The entry must be the authors original work and in English
6. One entry per person only
7. The entry must not exceed 2500 words
8. Entries need to use:
 - A4 paper
 - 12pt font
 - Courier new, Arial or Times New Roman font
 - Double spacing
 - Page numbering
9. The author's name should not appear on the entry itself
10. All entries must be submitted with an official entry form
11. Once an entry is submitted, the entry is final. The entry may not be withdrawn or alterations made.
12. The judges' decision is final. Judges' reserve the right to not award prizes.
13. The top 3 entries for each category will be developed into an online anthology. Council Staff have the final decision on published content of the anthology.
14. Entrants grant the Campbelltown City Council a non-exclusive, personal, perpetual, royalty free licence to publish (including electronically), broadcast, edit and adapt the awarded entry.

CATEGORIES

Junior Writer (7 – 11 years old)

Gold, Silver and Bronze winners all receive \$30

Youth Writer (12- 25 years old)

Gold, Silver and Bronze winners all receive \$80

Open Writer (25 years +)

Gold, Silver and Bronze winners all receive \$200

One overall winner will also receive an additional \$200

All prize winners will also have the opportunity for a one hour personal writing mentoring session.

A presentation evening will be held at the Campbelltown Library to announce the winners.
